

Do You Hear What I Hear?

*"He said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter felt hurt because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" And he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said, to him, "Feed my sheep."
John 21:17*

Moving Forward

Warden's Corner with Jon Reily

Hello everyone!

Here's your weekly update. Archdeacon Besson met with the vestry after our worship service last Sunday. He went over the guidelines for the search process and mentioned resources that the diocesan office has to offer all parishes, not just those in a search process, for several areas of ministry. He was very encouraging about our ability to find a new rector, confiding that there is already some interest.



Archdeacon Besson also stated that he and Bishop Reed are in conversation with someone who is praying about becoming our interim rector with the hopes that this person would start sometime in September. So, we don't have any information other than that to report on that front. However, when we know who it is and which Sunday will be his or her first Sunday with us, we'll welcome our interim in true St. Mark's fashion with a wonderful pot luck lunch.

The search process for our new rector will take between six months and a year, and it will be strictly confidential in nature. Selections for the Search committee will begin soon. Please keep that process in your prayers. The committee will be comprised of eight to ten people with a variety of backgrounds (time at St. Mark's, age, and ministry involvement) to ensure that the wider congregation will be well represented. This group will be commissioned to begin its work during a Sunday worship service.

Tony Reyes will be our guest speaker this Sunday as we worship through Morning Prayer. He is the director and founder of Mission 911, a ministry we have supported through our Outreach Fund for many years. Rev. Betty Fuller will celebrate Holy Eucharist the following two Sundays, 8/22 and 8/29, to finish out the month of August.

- Through your cell phone using our app, Give+Plus. To get the app, go to the app store and search for "Give+Plus". The icon background is white, the word "Give" is gray and the "+Plus" is a mustard color. Download the app and follow the prompts. You can use it to set up a one-time gift or recurring gifts.
- Mail in your check to: St. Mark's Church, 2727 Airline Rd, CC, TX 78414. We have a drop-in mailbox that is locked at all times. We will be checking the mail every day, so your check will be secure.
- Drop your check off at the church. Just put it in the locked mailbox to the left of the red door at the fellowship hall.
