From the Rector Fr. Doug Wasinger



Jesus drew attention from all walks of life. As he moved through his ministry, he touched hearts, challenged the norms of his time, and reminded people that they were not objects to be controlled but children of God, inherently valuable. He showed them that their worth wasn't based on accomplishments but on their identity as human beings, full of dreams and hopes, capable of generosity and compassion. What many lacked was the confidence to simply be human—and the understanding that this, too, is sacred.

In Luke 14, Jesus is invited to a dinner. The atmosphere is tense. People are watching him closely, expecting something controversial. Jesus, ever perceptive, reads the room. He knows their expectations, and he doesn't disappoint. But instead of stirring conflict, he highlights a simple truth: true confidence in being a child of God allows a person to be humble.

- Donating sleeping bags, backpacks, tote bags, suitcases, and recyclable plastic bags
- Donating travel size deodorant, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, bars of bath soap, body wash, bath towels
- Donating toothbrushes and new or used shoelaces
- Donating laundry supplies
- Donating items for to-go food bags: tuna and cracker packs, granola bars, chips, bottled water, etc.
- Sorting clothing and helping clients on Mondays from 8:45 - noon

- Drop your check off at the church. Just put it in the locked mailbox to the left of the red doors at the fellowship hall.
