# Fr. Doug Wasinger



I was fortunate to participate in a program called Senior Seminar, based on experience driven learning, during the second semester of my high school senior year. One aspect of the program was public service. I enjoyed being around horses and wanted to learn more about riding, so I signed up for Horse Therapy.

One requirement of those who are riding horses is to grip the mane of the horse. One afternoon when a group arrived for a session, we three volunteers were assigned a young boy who avoided the world by holding his hands close to his face to shield himself from external information. We made it clear that he had to hang on or he would fall off, but he would let go when he got tired of dealing with the instructions and default to holding his hands in front of his face. So, while ensuring the boy's safety, the volunteer team instructed the riders to make a sharp turn which made him fall off. Feeling the impact of hitting the ground helped motivate him to hang on, stretching his mind to engage in his immediate environment. The therapy session worked. By the end of the session, the boy was looking around and consistently hanging on to the horse. He was participating in the healthy behavior of acknowledging the world around him and had dropped his unhealthy selfprotective shield of avoidance.

### **Remind Church Texting Service**

We plan to use REMIND text messaging service as a communication tool. REMIND will give us the ability to send text messages directly to your phone, and it will allow you to respond with a message if necessary.

We are using the free version and are limited on the number of groups we may create. Below is a list of nine groups that have been created for our ministries, some of which have been combined. If this works well for us, we may expand our plan to include more ministry groups.

We are aware that some of you have had issues trying to connect with the group you need to be part of. We recently learned that we can send a text to you inviting you to join a specific group. You will need to download the REMIND app. We will work on sending out messages to those who have not yet signed up for a ministry group that they should be a part of in the coming weeks, so be on the look out for that text.

You may also sign up for your specific ministry group using the information below. We're asking everyone to sign up for the **"General Announcements"** group because it will be used for event reminders and emergency related information. That group will be one-way texting only.   drop-in mailbox that is locked at all times. We check the mail every day, so your check
  will be secure.
