Reflections from the Rector



Paul, who wrote letters to the early Church, had his work cut out for him. As a Jew, he inherited an identity that encouraged loyalty to his religious heritage, even at the cost of being separated from the surrounding culture. But after being transformed by the grace of Jesus, Paul found himself wrestling to reconcile his revealed understanding of God with his previous upbringing.

Prior to his conversion encounter with the risen Jesus, Paul held a firm belief that following the Law of Moses was the primary way Israel would honor God's blessing. Then his understanding shifted. The Law of Moses demonstrated humanity's need for a Savior because no one could ever fully fulfill what God asked of Israel. This revelation was actually good news because it pointed toward a solution

for meeting an impossible standard. Through his resurrection, Jesus revealed God's heart: to touch human lives through a spirit of love rooted in mercy and joy. As theologian Kyle Fedler put it, "He [Jesus] lived the life the Torah was designed to create." The Law's fullest purpose was redemption through mercy. Paul argued that what matters now is not rigid adherence to the letter of the law but the embracing of the spirit of the law.
