Reflections from the Rector



Welcome to the "regular season" in the Episcopal Church. While school is out for the summer, church is in session. Over the next couple of months, we will focus on the teachings and actions of Jesus in the Gospels. Throughout his ministry, Jesus follows a consistent theme: liberating people from their physical and spiritual burdens.

This week, we pick up Jesus's story in Matthew. Early in his earthly ministry, Jesus ventures from his hometown into the wider region, teaching in synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the Kingdom of God. This news naturally catches the community's attention. As word spreads about Jesus healing the disenfranchised and reframing the Hebrew scriptures, people want more. Instead of seeing the growing crowds as a limitation, Jesus uses

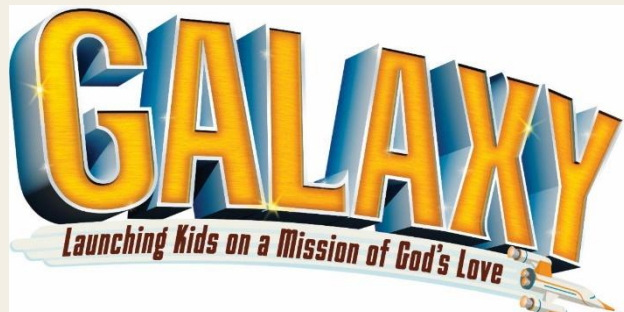
Food Delivery to Residents on the Third Monday of Every Month at 11:30 a.m.

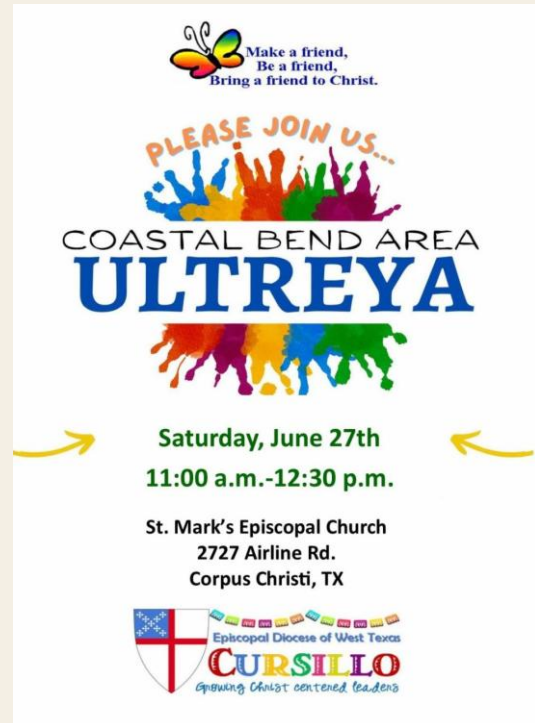

- You may also use the QR code below.
- Mail in your check to: St. Mark's Church, 2727 Airline Rd, CC, TX 78414. We have a drop-in mailbox that is locked at all times. We check the mail every day, so your check will be secure.
- Drop your check off at the church. Just put it in the locked mailbox to the left of the red doors at the fellowship hall.
