### **Stuffed Animal Drive to Benefit the Children of Plaza de Paz**

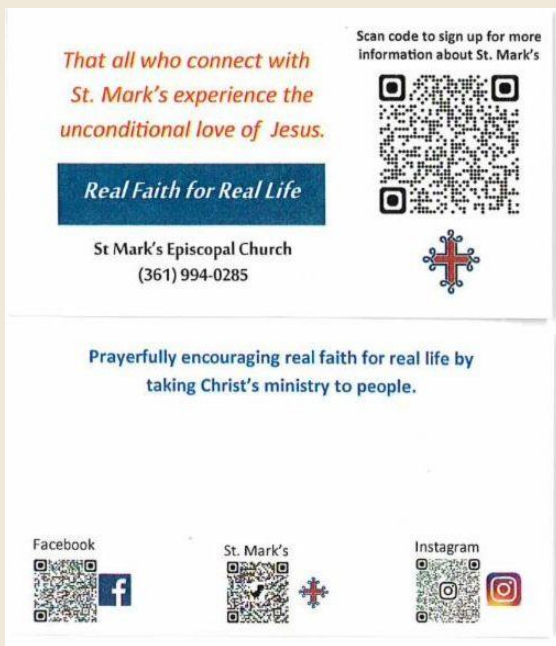
**Deadline October 6th**
