

a devotional by Susie Larson.**

"Then he added, 'Son of man, let all my words to sink deep into your own heart first. Listen to them carefully for yourself.'"
Ezekiel 3:10

How often do we listen to sermons, read books, and take notes for everybody else? We hear a good point and we want to remember it for a friend. Or we hear a word of correction and wish so-and-so could hear it. But when we listen for others and not for ourselves, we skim the surface of what God is saying, and we miss the potency of God's living, breathing word to us. It's easy to view God as a content machine from whom we get tidbits of wisdom and meme-able phrases. He is the living God who spoke the world into existence. He gave us His living, active Word to teach us and train us so we could truly know Him. We need God's consistent voice in our lives like we need oxygen. And He does indeed want to speak through us, but He'll do so only to the extent that we allow Him to speak first to us. Some words will be just for us, not for public consumption. Others, God wants to season with time before we share them. And

still others, well, they must be shouted from the rooftops. How do we discern the difference? The more secure we are in Him, the easier it'll be to know when to hold our words and when to share them.




Lenten Group Discussion

Rather than suggesting a normal Bible reading, I am putting forth a poem by the Christian apologist Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn.

*"How easy it is to live with You, O Lord.
How easy to believe in You.
When my spirit is overwhelmed within me,
when even the keenest see no further than the night,
and know not what to do tomorrow,
You bestow on me the certitude
that You exist and are mindful of me,
that all the paths of righteousness are not barred.
As I ascend in to the hill of earthly glory,
I turn back and gaze, astonished, on the road
that led me here beyond despair,
where I too may reflect Your radiance upon mankind.
All that I may reflect, You shall accord me,
and appoint others where I shall fail."*

In 1972, Solzhenitsyn publicly declared his faith and released a poem written some ten years earlier in prison. It tells us much about this man who is surely a modern hero even in a hyper-cynical world... Regardless of our individual beliefs, such devoted testimony and dedication behooves each of us to reflect again on our unique calling, our special mission on this earth.

- **NEW APP**----Through your cell phone using the app, Vanco Mobile. To get the app, go to the app store and search for "Vanco Mobile". The icon background is dark purple with a white circle and a purple letter "V" in the center. Download the app and follow the prompts. You can use it to set up a one-time gift or recurring gifts.
- Mail in your check to: St. Mark's Church, 2727 Airline Rd, CC, TX 78414. We have a drop-in mailbox that is locked at all times. We check the mail every day, so your check will be secure.
- Drop your check off at the church. Just put it in the locked mailbox to the left of the red doors at the fellowship hall.
